

Shaykh Ibn ‘Uthaymīn: Revolting Against the Rulers is the Most Corrupt, Vile Innovation



Shaykh Ibn ‘Uthaymīn (رَحْمَةُ اللَّهِ) said: And rebelling against the ruler, there is no doubt it is from the most corrupt of innovations, the most vile of them and the most evil of them. The ummah was not torn to pieces except due to rebelling against its rulers. The strange thing is that those who rebelled against the rulers, their (stated) aim is rectitude, and they call out with rectitude, they call out with rectification. Until the Messenger of Allāh (صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ) informed that the Companions would belittle their own prayer and recitation compared to theirs (the Khārijites who rebelled), however that their faith, and refuge is from Allāh, will not pass their throats. We ask Allāh for pardon.
